## Higher Denham Open Gardens



On Sunday 30th June, at least six local gardens will be open from 2.00pm until 5.30pm, in support of the National Garden Scheme (NGS) and the Higher Denham Community Garden. Tickets cost £6.00 for admission to all the gardens and can be purchased at the Hall.

**Wind in the Willows** has over 350 shrubs and trees, informal woodland and wild gardens including riverside and bog plantings. Owner Ron James will lead optional guided tours of his garden starting at 2.30pm and 4.00pm. Tours last around an hour. The garden was open to the public back in March and took £1440, the most ever raised at a March event.



The garden at **5 Side Road** is medium sized with lawns, borders and shrubs, and many features which children will love. **9 Lower Road** is a small garden backing onto the river. Recently professionally designed, it is now maturing and has new shrubs.



The **25 Lower Road** front garden has been completely redesigned with raised beds, richly filled with plants and shrubs to create a vibrant instant garden. Open for the first time last year, it was greatly admired. At **30 Lower Road** you will find a well-stocked garden with charm and character including a wartime underground bunker! **19 Middle Road** with contrasting dry front and damper back garden is re-opening this year.

## Draft Chiltern and South Bucks Local Plan 2036

Both Chiltern and South Bucks District Councils approved the draft Local Plan for publication and submission at their Full Council meetings on 14th and 15th May 2019.

**We have been advised by Denham Parish Council that the plan proposes to remove the settlements of Higher Denham, Denham Village and Tatling End from the Green Belt.**

This draft plan is subject to a Public Consultation which started on Friday 7th June and will run until Friday 19th July 2019. Chiltern and South Bucks District Councils are holding the six-week public consultation and invite you to comment on the "soundness" of the local plan.

**Residents are strongly advised to comment on the proposal before the deadline.**
