Community Governance Review 2018

South Bucks District Council (SBDC) is carrying out a review of parish councils in Denham, Farnham Royal and Stoke Poges. The review will be focusing on council size; the number of councillors to be elected to the council, and warding arrangements; the number, size and naming of electoral wards.

As part of the review, SBDC is conducting a public consultation which started on 3 September and **will run until Friday 12 October 2018**.

Currently Denham is split into three 'Wards' for voting purposes: Denham North, Denham South and Denham South West. However, the Councillors do not manage Denham as '3 WARDS' which are artificial dividers, but as '1 WARD'. They are aware that there are at least five hamlets in Denham that have different profiles and the Parish Council tries to address all issues whilst bearing in mind their individual needs. They are seeking your support for their submission to SBDC for Denham to be classed as ONE WARD.

Local issues

Fly-tipping Old Rectory Lane — further to the update in the last issue, Bucks County Council is in contact with the land owner as no progress has been made regarding clearing the site.

Watch found on the Glebe Field — if you have recently lost a watch please contact the Editor or any one of the Committee.

A number of Higher Denham residents have been in touch about issues of concern to them, including:

Road safety— over recent months there seems to be more people than usual walking up and down Old Rectory Lane. Don't forget there is a footpath to Denham Green that runs around the edge of the adjacent field and is a much safer route. Remember too that the speed limit in Higher Denham is 30mph which is regularly exceeded, particularly along Lower Road.

Parking on pavements— there is also more parking on pavements causing obstruction for people on foot who often have to step into the road to walk along.

Bonfires — the unpleasantness caused when someone chooses to burn a bonfire. On bright, dry days, the smell prevents neighbours from being able to open doors and windows in their home, spend time in their own garden and put washing out.
